
Is this intended to be a 5<sup>th</sup> Key Staff member and if so, will an additional half-page be allotted for Item 7 Key Staff half-page resumes?"

A1: **No. This is the requirement for a Supplemental Support On-Site Engineer. No resume is required.**


Q2: May we please know who the incumbents are for this contract?
